**MARRIAGE PREPARATION:** Our diocesan policy requires the parish priest be contacted at least six months prior to the *proposed* date of the couples' wedding to schedule preparation catechesis.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** If facing serious illness, please contact the parish office to arrange for anointing.

**CONFIRMATION:** Preparation for Confirmation in 2018 began August 21, 2016 for 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade students.





**“Quotables” on the Liturgy:** “The ideal of Christian life is that each one be united to God in the closest and most intimate manner. For this reason, the worship that the Church renders to God, and which is based especially on the eucharistic sacrifice and the use of the sacraments, is directed and arranged in such a way that it embraces by means of the divine office, the hours of the day, the weeks and the whole cycle of the year, and reaches all the aspects and phases of human life.” [Pope Pius XII, Encyclical on the Sacred Liturgy, 138]

**Transfiguration:** Jesus’ Transfiguration confirms his divine Sonship. It also strengthens three early Church leaders (Peter, James, and John)...being transfigured before them, Jesus unveils his glory, later manifest in his Resurrection and shared by his angels and Virgin Mother in heaven.
